- Only grades of "C-" or above may be used in completing minor requirements.
- Any minor course substitutions or waivers must be pre-approved by Joshua Ross or the Office of Undergraduate Programs.
- Students with a minor in *both* Business Administration and Entrepreneurship will **not** be able to count BUS 1440 toward both minors simultaneously. Instead, an additional four-credit EVM course will be needed in the Entrepreneurship minor.
